**Reboletti Calls for Governor to Immediately Resign or Face  
Impeachment Proceedings**

**Addison ...** In light of criminal charges filed against the Governor, State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) calls for Governor Blagojevich to immediately resign or face an impeachment trial before the General Assembly.

“Even though there has been speculation about corruption in the Governor’s administration, I think we were all surprised to learn what lengths the Governor was willing to go to benefit himself,” said Rep. Reboletti. “Governor Blagojevich needs to resign. At this point, I would say we don’t have a chief executive at the wheel and that’s a scary position for this state. With a tumbling economy, high unemployment, home foreclosures and a state that is billions in the red, we need a leader to step in and fill that constitutional void. It’s a disservice to the taxpayers for the Governor to continue his charade.”

Yesterday, Rep. Reboletti along with other House Republican members filed House Resolution 1644 which would create a bi-partisan committee to investigate the grounds for impeachment. If the House approves the cause for impeachment of the Governor, the case would be tried in the Senate. A vote for impeachment in the Senate would require a 2/3rds majority vote.

“The act of impeaching any government official is a very serious and large undertaking by the legislature. Based on allegations of Blagojevich selling a US Senate seat, extorting a children’s hospital CEO and threatening the employment of the Tribune editorial board, I feel that these charges are serious enough for the legislature to begin the process,” said Rep. Reboletti.
