Reboletti Reminds Parents of School Supply Tax Holiday

Addison, IL ... Recognizing the costliness of school registration, classroom supplies and clothing, State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) helped pass legislation creating the state's first ever School Supply Tax Holiday.

"Having a son of my own, I know first-hand the cost on parents when preparing their children for school. Times are tough for all families right now and I hope this tax break will help ease some of the burden," said Reboletti.

The School Supply Tax Holiday will be held from August 6-15 and will consist of a 10-day period during which consumers can purchase certain items and pay the state sales tax at a reduced rate. The state sales tax on these items will be at the rate of 1.25% instead of 6.25%.

Items include clothing and footwear priced under \$100 and certain school supplies such as binders, book bags, calculators, pens, pencils, rulers, notebook paper and lunchboxes. School supplies are not subject to the \$100 threshold. Computers, electronics, art supplies and athletic shoes do not qualify for the tax break. Local sales taxes will still be collected.
